On Wednesday, we were given an opportunity to review public interest polling and insights to give a better landscape of how the American people currently feel on a variety of issues. Also learned of best practices in communicating to constituents on these issues. We also discussed finding common goals as well as important ethics reminders and tips for record-keeping.

Thursday, we heard from leadership teams regarding priorities for the 118th and how to work together to deliver results for the American people while avoiding procedural hiccups. In terms of my personal habits, the most impactful session was on management and leadership. The lecture has already changed my routines, specifically with scheduling on my calendar and goal setting. One-on-ones and other structural changes to better improve the inner functioning of our office so we can better serve constituents. We then had a great lunch lecture on the importance of history, before breaking into groups for discussions on crisis management and digital operations where I was able to share some of our office's best practices and learn other approaches. During dinner, diplomats from European countries provided valuable insights on NATO, energy policy, and the war in Ukraine.

Finally, on Friday, we started the day discussing conducting oversight. We reviewed effective and ineffective tactics and seeing the bigger picture in regard to goals. After that, I had the opportunity to deepen my understanding of the Appropriations Committee and the processes and timelines, as well as resources like CBO reports available. Finally, we closed with a panel on *Dobbs*, examining public polling and the political landscape ahead.
