

Pursuant to House Rule 25, clause 5(d)(2), the Committee on Ethics hereby approves your proposed trip to Baltimore, Maryland, scheduled for October 12, 2023, sponsored by National Park Foundation, Coca-Cola Company, and Forward Global. Finally, Travel Regulation § 404(d) also requires you to keep a copy of all request forms and supporting information provided to the Committee for three subsequent Congresses from the date of travel.

Schedule in Eastern time

- 8:00 AM** Staffers arrive at Union Station for pick-up
- 8:15 AM** Staffers depart Union Station by bus to Fort McHenry
- 8:30 AM** Staffers briefed on NPF Partnerships and the Foundation by NPF Team
- Since Congress established NPF as the official nonprofit partner of NPS in 1967, they've supported parks and the vital work of NPS in a variety of ways. And as parks age and visitation increases, the National Park Foundation (NPF) is uniquely positioned to help fund both the preservation and growth of the National Park Service and all 400+ beloved national parks. NPF staffers will delve into how the Foundation engages in fundraising efforts for NPS, conservation and connectivity programs, as well as community outreach.
- 9:30 AM** Arrive at Fort McHenry
- 9:45 AM** Receive official welcome from National Park Service Rangers, and watch brief video on Fort McHenry history
- Fort McHenry is a historical American fort in the Locust Point neighborhood of Baltimore, Maryland. Though Fort McHenry is best known for its role in the War of 1812 when it successfully defended Baltimore Harbor from the British navy, it was also used by armed forces in the Civil War, World War I, and World War II. First built in 1798, the 43-acre fort was designated as a national monument in 1939 and added to the historical register in 1966, a true homage to its permanent significance in American history. Fort McHenry attracts more than 635,000 visitors annually.

- 10:00 AM** Official flag change demonstration and ceremony
- 10:15 AM** Begin tour of Fort McHenry and watch living history demonstration
- Staffers will join rangers to explore the role of Fort McHenry in securing Maryland for the Union during the Civil War, and to

examine how its role as a prison and center of martial rule in Baltimore help Americans to consider the delicate balance between ensuring national security and safeguarding civil liberties.

11:30 AM

Discussion of Battle of Baltimore & Star Spangled Banner

- The Battle of Baltimore (1814) is known as the defining moment in the War of 1812 and would inspire Francis Scott Key to write “The Star Spangled Banner.” Staffers will be briefed on the events leading up to and the battle, how the battle transpired, and the importance of the win on American history. Staffers will have the unique opportunity to see the original flag that flew over Fort McHenry following victory.

12:15 PM

Lunch with keynote speaker from NPF leadership outlining the importance of the “your park your story” initiative

- To commemorate the National Park Service’s 107th anniversary, the National Park Foundation launched a “Your Park. Your Story” theme. NPF believes that parks are intrinsically personal. Everybody has the potential to have their own unique connection to national parks, and people everywhere should be strongly encouraged to explore parks to develop their own story. From experiencing the restorative benefits of nature to witnessing history parks preserve, a unique thread ties everyone to national parks. Through this staff delegation, NPF invites staffers to find their place in parks and discover their park connection.

Staffers briefed on history and importance of Hampton National Historic Site

- Hampton National Historic Site, established in 1948, is a 62-acre preservation of what was once a large commercial, industrial, and agricultural estate owned by the Ridgely family for seven generations (1745-1948). The site features a Georgian manor house, gardens, grounds, and original stone slave quarters. Its preserved structure and slave quarters provides a unique perspective into 18th and 19th-century landowning aristocracy. Hampton National Historic Site was the first National Historic Site selected by the National Park Service in 1948. Today, it attracts more than 40,000 visitors annually.

- 2:15 PM** Arrive at Hampton National Historic Site and official welcome by National Park Service staff
- 2:30 PM** Hampton National Historic Site Grounds and Mansion Tour guided by onsite historian
- Tours of the Hampton Mansion offer insight as to how the Ridgley family, European indentured servants, enslaved African-Americans, and paid laborers lived. Visitors will walk the halls of the historic structure and learn about its architectural features, artwork, and thousands of other authentic seasonal collection items on display.
