





Dear Mr. Podliska:

Pursuant to House Rule 25, clause 5(d)(2), the Committee on Ethics hereby approves your proposed trip to Ponte Vedra, Florida, scheduled for March 6 to 8, 2025, sponsored by Coalition for a Prosperous America Education Fund. Finally, Travel Regulation § 404(d) also requires you to keep a copy of all request forms and supporting information provided to the Committee for three subsequent Congresses from the date of travel.
