Withdrawal of Candidate Abdullah Issaq

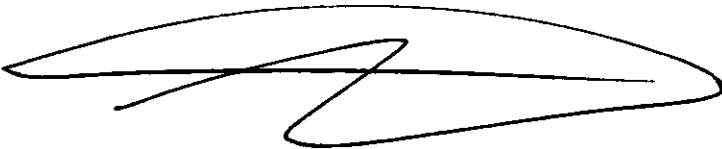
Effective January 1st, Abdullah Issaq withdrew his candidacy for CA 19 House of Representatives 2020.

"To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to acknowledge my withdrawal from the race for California's 19th Congressional District House Race.

As a high school civics teacher I wanted to show my students the different elements of what is required to run for Congress. At no point did I plan on mounting a legitimate run. I did not officially have my name put on the ballot nor did I fundraise a single dollar for my campaign. In accordance with the House Committee on Ethics I am formally submitting this letter announcing that I have withdrawn from the ~~raise~~ race and did not raise any funds to disclose.
